

Dear X MP,

I hope you can help me and thousands of other women of my age in our constituency. As you may know, the Parliamentary and Health Service Ombudsman reported a year ago that the Department of work and Pensions had let down women born in the 1950s. The PHSO is clear that DWP's failure to let women know about changes to the State Pension age was maladministration.

There is a lot of misinformation around the WASPI campaign and I wanted to ask if you knew that:

- WASPI is campaigning for compensation, not for the State Pension age to go back to 60.
- 220,000 women have died while waiting for the Ombudsman to conduct the investigation.
- One woman born in the 1950s is dying every 14 minutes while they wait for compensation.
- The Ombudsman has found clear evidence of maladministration by the DWP.
- The Ombudsman has encouraged the DWP to be 'proactive' in considering compensation now.
- The Pensions Minister consistently refuses to meet with WASPI women, hiding behind the false idea that we want the State Pension age changed back!
